A SIMPLE GUIDE TO CREATING YOUR BIOGRAPHY Doctor Biography Cards

It's hard to talk about yourself. But it's critical for your dental practice that you share your story with your patients so they know they are getting great, quality care from an experienced professional who cares about their oral health.

Follow these easy steps to a great biography. Simple and short (125-word max). Write in third-person, or as an outsider looking in, using pronouns such as he, she, it, or they.

1. Your name in the header

2. First paragraph includes:

- a. How long you have been practicing. This can be written two ways:
 - i. Dr. John Doe is a certified dentist who has been practicing since 2002.
 - ii. Dr. John Doe is a certified dentist who has been practicing for 25 years.
- b. Your specialties (Name at least three)
 - i. He specializes in diagnosing and treating patients with the following conditions: periodontal disease, tooth decay, tooth aches, and dental emergencies.

3. Second paragraph includes:

- a. Your education
 - i. Dr. John Doe graduated from Baylor College of Dentistry in 1996. He received his Master of Science and Certificate in Dentistry from the University of Detroit in 2002.
- b. Your membership in associations (Name as many as possible. Make sure you have the correct name of the association / organization. Double check on the association's / organization's website to make sure you have spelled that correctly.)
 - ii. Dr. Doe also is member of Michigan Association of Dentistry, Great Lakes Association of Dentistry, American Dental Association, Michigan Dental Association and the Oakland County Dental Society.

4. Third paragraph (optional) includes:

- a. Any philanthropy / charity work you do connected to your dentistry
 - i. Dr. Doe believes in giving back to his community and often assists with establishing dental programs for the elderly in long-term care facilities. He also gives talks at schools to children about the importance of good dental hygiene.

Tip: Always proof your bio and have another set of eyes look at it before you use it!
